

CONSTRUCTING THE YI BIN FOLK SONGS GUIDEBOOK FOR TEACHING

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Yibin City is located in the hinterland of south Sichuan Province, is a bright pearl in the south of Sichuan Province, its unique geographical position gives the city rich historical and cultural heritage. Located at the junction of Yunguichuan and Guizhou provinces, Yibin is an important confluence point of Jinsha River, Minjiang River and Yangtze River. The geographical characteristics of the confluence of these three rivers give Yibin unique resources and strategic position, and it is known as "the first city on the Yangtze River" (Xu Jing, 2013). These Yibin folk songs are not only reflected in the regional culture, but also have high research value in the era atmosphere and artistic expression. The content of the song is closely related to People's Daily life, and the lyrics are easy to understand and express deep emotions. The usual sentence pattern is composed of two or four verses, and the lyrics flexibly use the techniques of contrast, exaggeration, personification, metaphor and narrative, and highlight the central idea through short and powerful paragraphs to make the

Modern music propaganda channels are more diverse and extensive, from music classes to TV, radio, and then to all kinds of music platforms on the Internet, modern music is not only promoted in education, but also in the media communication has been a huge exposure. In contrast, for traditional Chinese music, especially local music such as Yibin folk songs, the publicity channels are limited and attention is quite limited. Although Yibin folk songs have profound cultural connotation and high artistic value, it is difficult to attract enough attention and inheritance. This situation leads to Yibin folk songs fail to keep up with the pace of The Times, and most people lack understanding and acceptance of it. Therefore, the design of vocal singing teaching methods and processes of Yibin folk songs for college students and the inclusion of Yibin folk songs in college courses will help college students become active promoters of Yibin folk songs inheritance. By cultivating college students' singing skills of Yibin folk songs through professional music education, they will be able to better understand and express the emotion and connotation of this unique musical form. In teaching, the history, culture and regional characteristics of Yibin folk songs can be combined to let students deeply understand the origin of Yibin folk songs and cultivate their love and responsibility for this tradition. By learning Yibin folk songs, college students will not only be inheritors, but also cultural disseminators. As a new force in the society, they can present Yibin folk songs to a wider audience through campus concerts, artistic performances and other forms, and promote the spread of Yibin folk songs among the young generation.
